A special meeting of Hanahan City Council was held on Wednesday, August 13, 2015 in the Administrative Conference Room at 1255 Yeamans Hall Road in Hanahan. This meeting was advertised in the Post and Courier and a copy of the Agenda was sent to reporter Brenda Rindge at the Post and Courier. The Agenda was posted on the City of Hanahan webpage and a copy of the Agenda was posted on the Bulletin Board at City Hall. Council Members present included: Michael Sally, Kevin Cox, Dan Owens, Joel Hodges, and Jeff Chandler. Council Member Dyson was not present. Johnny Cribb, City Administrator and Robbie Moffett, Human Resources Director was present for the interview process.

The meeting was called to order at 6:13 p.m. by the Honorable Mayor Minnie Newman. Council Member Cox led us in the Pledge of Allegiance. The first Candidate for Police Chief withdrew his application for consideration earlier in the week. Council Member Sally made a motion to enter into an Executive Session to conduct 2 personal interviews for consideration for the vacant police chief position. Mayor Pro-Tem Owens seconded the motion. All were in favor, none opposed.

Interviews concluded at 8:36 p.m. with discussion until 9:45 p.m. No action was taken in Executive Session.

Council returned from Executive at 9:46 p.m. Council Member Hodges made a motion to authorize Johnny Cribb, City Administrator to call Lt. Dennis Turner and offer him the Police Chief position at \$ 60,000 a year. Council Member Chandler seconded the motion. There was no discussion. All were in favor, none opposed. Motion carried 6-0. Chief Dennis Turner will take office immediately and be sworn in at the September 8th, 2015 regular City Council Meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:49 p.m.
