Special City Council Meeting

6:30 p.m.

A special meeting of Hanahan City Council was held on September 23, 2014. This meeting was advertised in the Post and Courier and on the City of Hanahan webpage. A copy of the Agenda was posted in the lobby at City Hall at least 24 hours prior to the meeting. A copy of the Agenda was sent to Brenda Rindge at the Post and Courier. Mayor Minnie Newman-Blackwell presided. Council members present were: Dan Owens, Michael Sally, Joel Hodges, Jeff Chandler, Mike Dyson and Kevin Cox. We had a quorum for tonight's meeting. Staff Members present were: Johnny Cribb, City Administrator, Kim Peters, Clerk of Council, Robbie Moffett, Human Resources Director and Courtney Soler, Finance Director.

CALL TO ORDER - Mayor Newman-Blackwell called the September 23, 2014 special City Council Meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

PLEDGE AND INVOCATION - Council Member Sally led us in the Lord's Prayer and Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

CITIZENS' COMMENTS - There were no Citizens' comments to discuss tonight.

OLD BUSINESS – 2nd reading of Ordinance # 7-2014 (Local Option Sales Tax and Millage Rate Adjustment amending the FY 2014-2015 Budget)

Council Member Owens made a motion to approve the 2nd reading of Ordinance # 7-2014. Council Member Sally seconded the motion. There was no discussion. All were in favor, none opposed. Motion carried 7-0.


EXECUTIVE SESSION – At 6:34 p.m. Mayor Pro-Tem Hodges made a motion to go into Executive Session to discuss a personnel matter relating to the evaluation of candidates for the vacant fire Chief Position and a personnel matter related to employee performance in the Administrative Office. Council Member Cox seconded the motion. There was no discussion. All were in favor, none opposed. Motion carried 7-0.

Council returned from Executive Session at 7:03. No action was taken while in Executive Session.

Mayor Pro-Tem Hodges made a motion to authorize Johnny Cribb to hire Bo Bowers from Awendaw as the City of Hanahan's new Fire Chief and offer him \$60,000 a year and to give Chief Mike Cochran, Police Chief a 5% raise. Council Member Owens seconded the motion. There was no discussion. The decision was unanimous. Mr. Bowers will start on October 10, 2014. Mayor Minnie Newman-Blackwell made a call to Mr. Bowers to offer him the job. He gladly accepted.

ADJOURNMENT- There being no further business to discuss, Mayor Pro-Tem Hodges made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Sally seconded the motion. All were in favor, none opposed. Motion carried 7-0. The meeting was adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
